課程概述 Course Descriptions & 學習目標 Learning Objectives	<p>This course is a general survey of British Victorian literature. Although the era was distinguished by novels, we will focus on poetry, prose, and drama instead. While reading texts of different genres, we will pay special attention to some important Victorian issues, such as gender, industrialism, science, imperialism and social critique. It is expected that students will be equipped with a basic understanding of Victorian literature and culture. The engagement in reading and critical analysis of literary texts and the exploration of Victorian issues will also sharpen students' overall keenness in reading comprehension, logical reasoning and insights into the issues in the past and the present, between the West and the East.</p>		
課程要求 Course Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Students are required to attend the class regularly and encouraged to participate in class discussion. Attendance policy: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Proof of leave must be submitted via the Student Leave Management System (學生請假系統) on the University's single sign-on portal (單一入口). Email leave notices are not accepted. ■ The course allows four leaves, regardless of any reason.
