課程目標 Course Objective	<p>Course Objectives / Learning Objectives</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will explore and recognize key issues related to food, clothing, housing, and medical care currently faced by both Taiwan and Japan. 2. Students will examine the relationship between Taiwan and Japan in the context of natural disasters. 3. Students will develop basic skills and awareness to assist people in need during emergencies. <p>This 150-minute class consists of two 50-minute sessions on culture followed by a 50-minute session on Japanese language each week, with two 10-minute breaks between the sessions. We will begin by reviewing hiragana and katakana. We will then move on to basic Japanese greetings. Because of this focus, we will not emphasize memorizing a large number of vocabulary items. Instead, we will explore the deeper meanings and appropriate uses of Japanese greetings—things that are often not explained in typical Japanese textbooks.</p>
