先修科目或先備能力 Prerequisites			
課程概述 Course Descriptions & 學習目標 Learning Objectives	This is a one-year compulsory course for the freshmen of the English majors. It aims to enhance students' listening comprehension and improve their speaking ability and presentation skills. The course will be processed in two tracks. Thematically, it centers on "how to tell great stories." Pragmatically, it is to orient students with academic English. To achieve these, students will undertake a variety of aural-oral trainings and engage with some technology tools and online resources. Through integrating listening and speaking activities, it is expected that students will be able to articulate clearly and correctly, express their opinions fluently, and discuss/communicate sensibly on world issues, academic topics or thematic materials.		
課程要求 Course Requirements	1. Students are required to attend the class regularly and are encouraged to participate in class discussions. 2. Attendance policy: ■ Proof of leave must be submitted via the Student Leave Management System (學生請假系統) on the University's single sign-on portal (單一入口). Email notices of leave are not accepted. ■ The course allows up to four absences , regardless of any reason. Two points will be deducted from the final grade for each absence if an online leave request is not submitted within three working days after the absence. ■ Four points will be deducted from the final grade starting with the fifth absence. ■ Two instances of being 15 minutes late will be counted as one absence. ■ The attendance policy outlined here applies to all students who register for the course at the beginning of the term. If, for any reason, you are unable to attend		

	class during the first two weeks of the term, you are strongly advised to withdraw from the course.			
	3. Students are required to complete their assignments independently. Plagiarism or unauthorized collaboration will lead to a zero on the assignment.			
	4. Makeup midterm/final exams and individual talk will only be permitted upon submission of valid documentation, within one week of the missed exam/talk, verifying an excused absence due to unforeseen circumstances. The documentation must bear the official stamp or seal of the issuing institution (e.g., a hospital, clinic, or government agency). A personal stamp or seal, including that of an individual physician, will not be accepted.
