課 程 概 述	<p>Delusions are a common symptom of schizophrenia and dementia. Though most English dictionaries define a delusion as a false opinion or belief, there is currently a lively debate about whether delusions are really beliefs and indeed, whether they are even irrational.</p> <p>In this seminar, we'll examine the interdisciplinary literature on the nature of delusions, covering the psychological literature on the aetiology and the behavioural manifestations of delusions, and the philosophical literature on belief ascription and rationality. By bringing together recent work in philosophy of mind, cognitive psychology and psychiatry, we'll discuss the philosophical issues raised by the psychology of normal and abnormal cognition.</p> <p>Moreover, what is the value of delusions and irrational beliefs? We'll read Lisa Bortolotti's forthcoming book <i>The Epistemic Innocence of Irrational Beliefs</i>, to explore this issue.</p>
