課程介紹與教學目標 Course Description and Objectives

Course Description:

The goal of this course is to develop and improve second-year English composition skills. In the second semester, we will continue learning a variety of English compositions, which include: ① "movie review essay," ②"classification essay," ③"causal analysis" (cause and effect), and then ④ "narrative essay." Throughout the course, we will not just enhance students' writing abilities and accurate usage of grammar. Various exercises will be added to the class and inspire students to draw upon specific examples and critical materials to each essay.

Course Objective:

This course is the second year of the two-year program of English writing and reading.

課程要求 Course Requirements

Requirements:

- (A) Composition: Four composition tasks are required this semester, concerning specified rhetorical patterns: classification, casual analysis, narrative essay, and movie review essay. Students are required to revise the compositions at least two times with peers' and the teacher's feedback.
- **(B) Grammar Exercises:** Grammar exercises are demanded each Tuesday. They include items of grammar, vocabulary, reading, and writing.
- **(C) Peer Review:** Each student is supposed to review three peers' drafts for each composition task. Review feedback should put an emphasis first on content and organization, and then on grammar, working and mechanics. Remember to sign your name.
- (D) Format of writings: (Times New Roman 12, 1.5 space; at least 500 words in length); They have to be submitted (uploaded) to **e-course** (教學課程平台) before

17:00 pm on the due date. In addition, a hard copy has to be turned in at the beginning of the class on the due date.
